- More awareness about eSafety





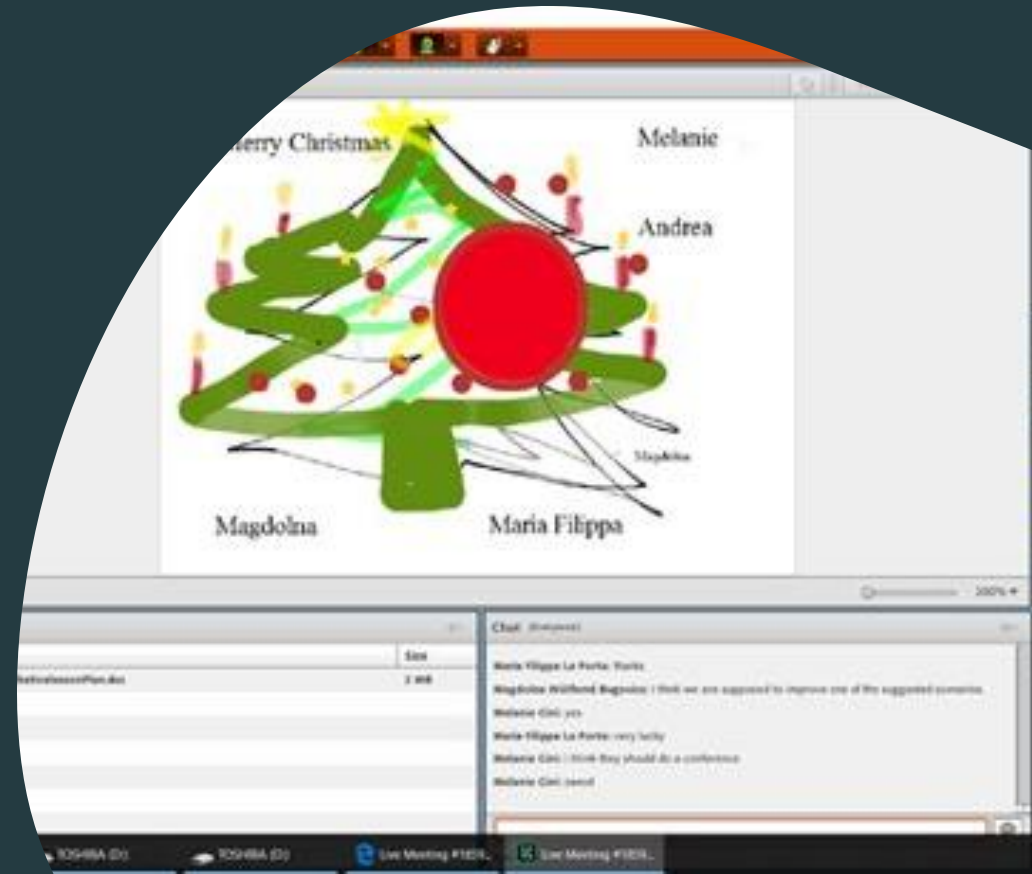
# An Opportunity for Growth

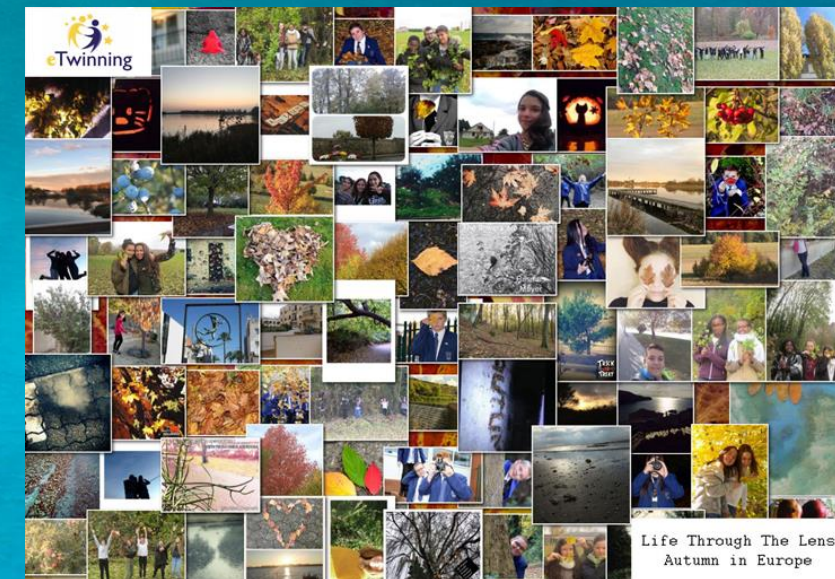

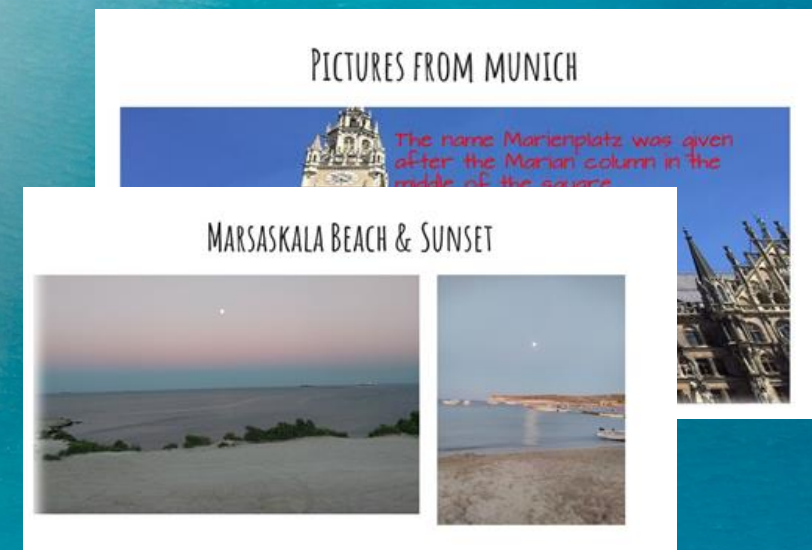


# Short Project Ideas – EFL students
