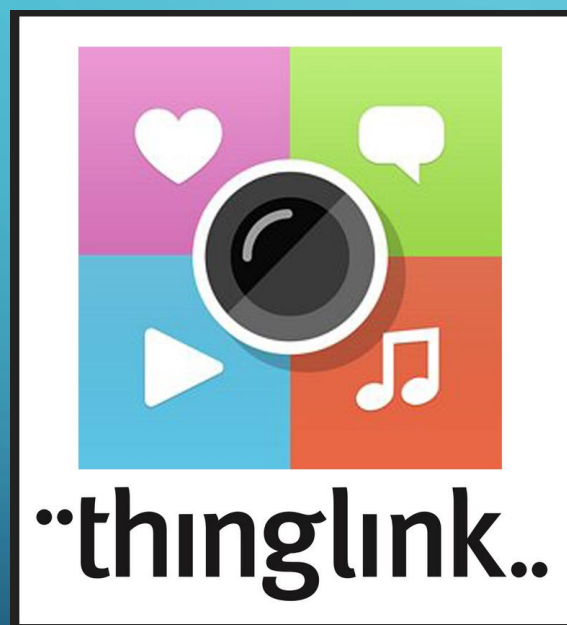

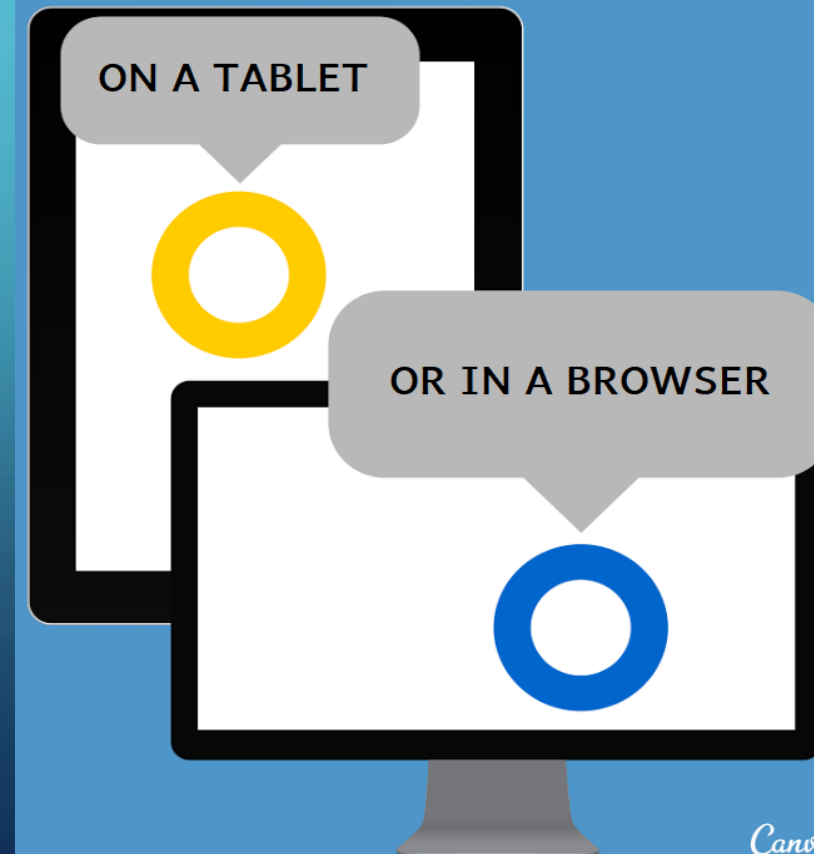
Information about Thinglink

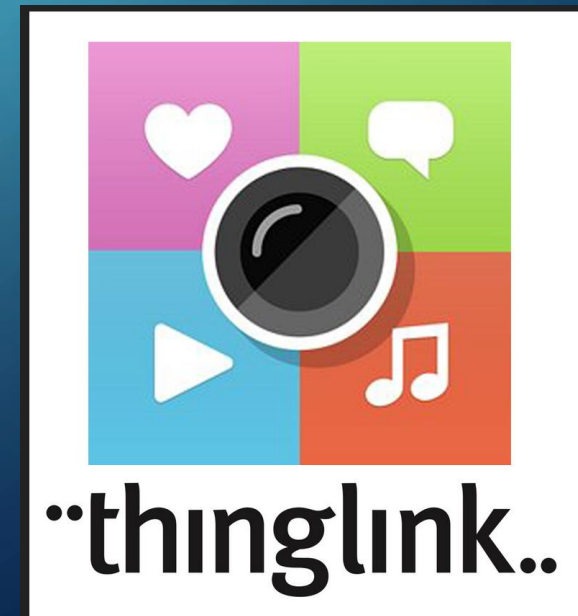




Ideas how ThingLink can be used during eTwinning projects

Add text and media

Multipurpose text & media tag that adapts its layout as you add content.



Add text label

Text label tag that displays text on hover.



Add content from website

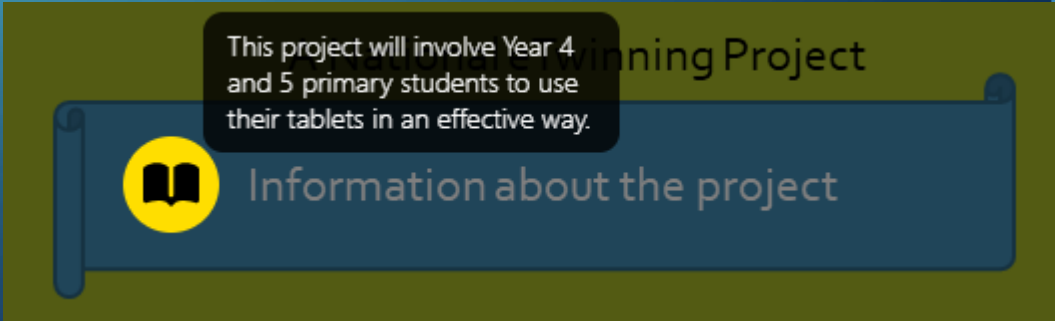
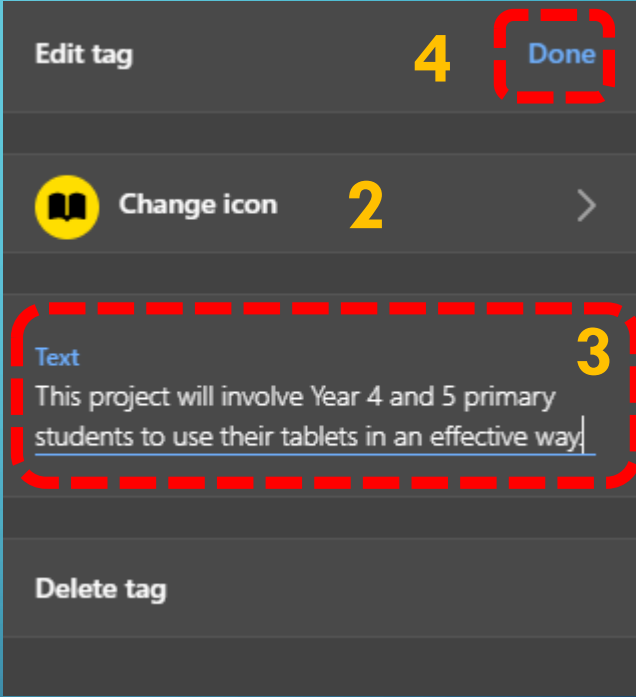
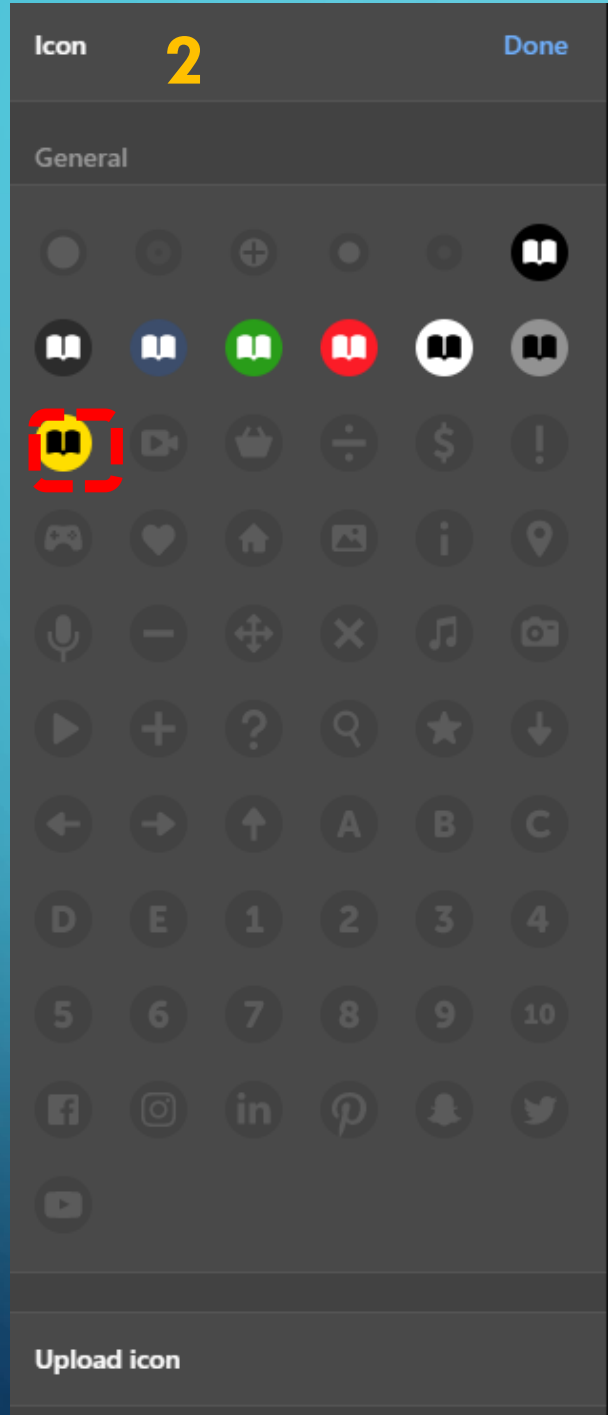
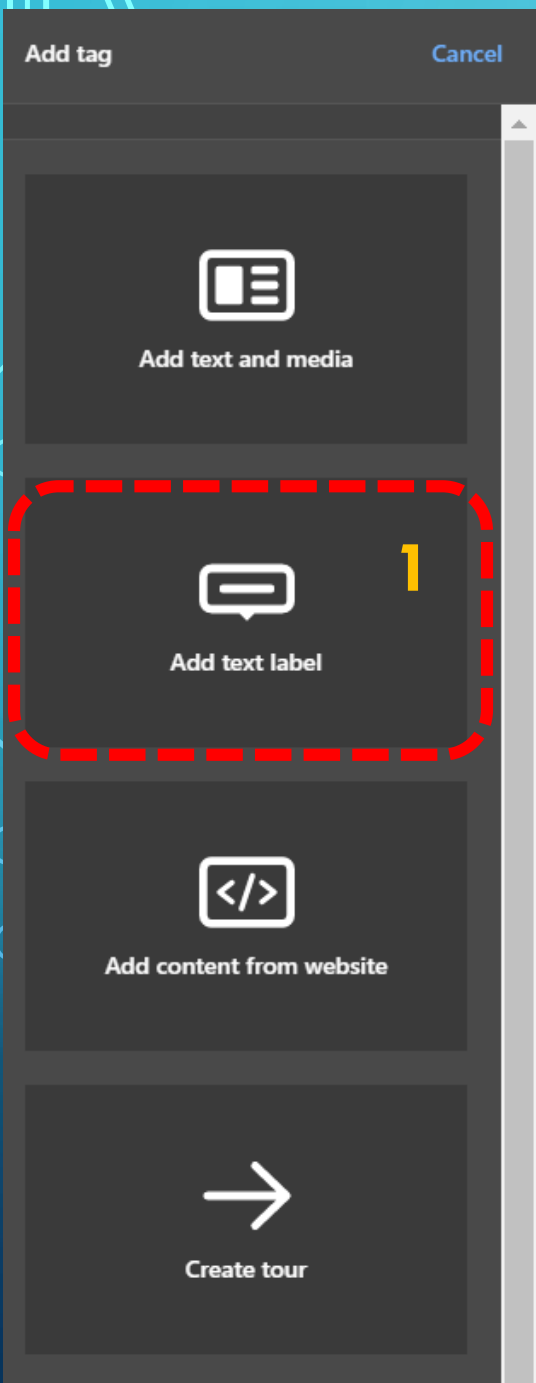
Add content from website tag. This tag allows you to embed third-party iframes or YouTube/Vimeo videos.

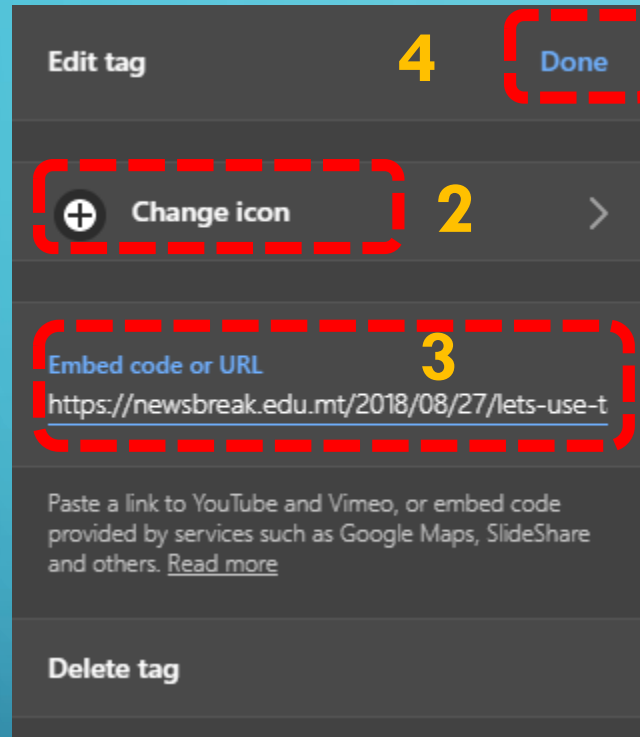
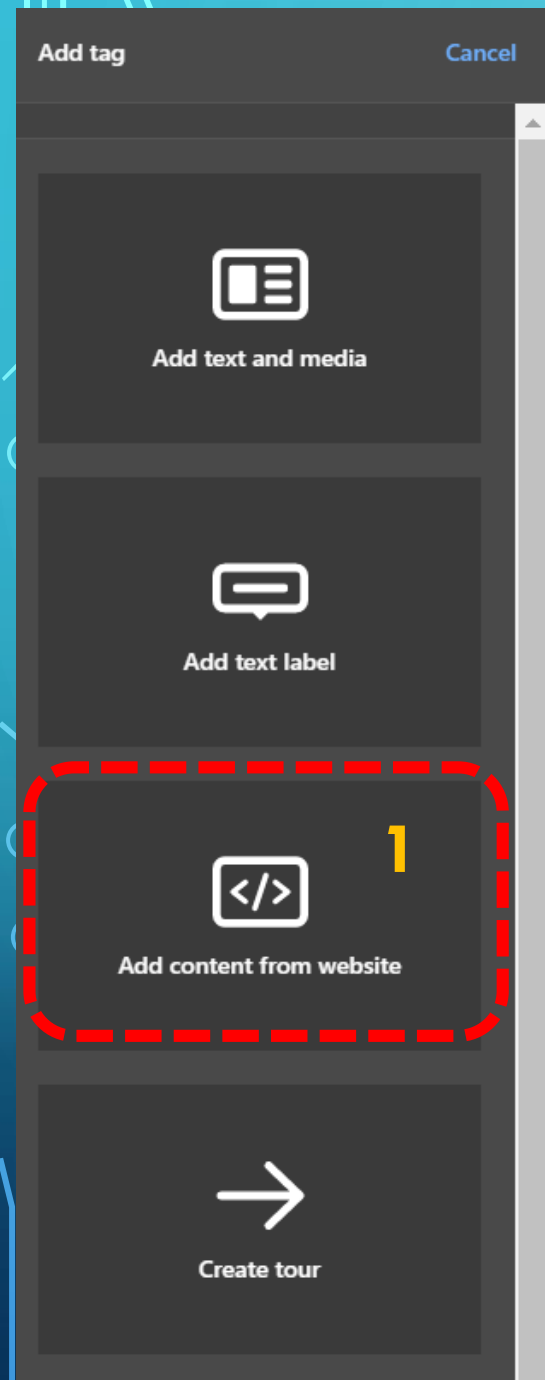
Adding a Text and Image Tag



1. Click on **Text and Media**.
2. Choose an icon to show that an image is going to be uploaded.
3. Write a small description about the image.
4. Click on **+ sign** to upload the image.
5. Then remember to click on **Done**.

Adding Content from website

1. Click on **Add content from website**.
2. Choose an icon.
3. Type the URL – the address of the website or link to YouTube video.
4. Then remember to click on **Done**.
